#### Propagation of the Holy Zoroastrian Religion in Olden Times

There is a continuous debate going on to determine whether in olden times, our Holy Zoroastrian Religion was propagated by our Mobeds. A direct reference to this propagation was presented in our previous WZSE #225 at: <u>http://www.avesta.org/wzse/wzse225.pdf</u>

from Yasna Haptanghaaiti - Yasna 42 - Verse 6 (Moti Haptan Yasht - Karda 8 - Verse 6).

It states:

"We praise the advent of the Athornaans, who go to distant places desiring to promote purity of the countries."

Kangaji in the footnote of page 189 says:

"Its significance appears to be that those Athornaans who go to other countries for the propagation of the holy Zoroastrian Religion may return safe after being fully successful in their good mission." This is the direct reference about the evangelical efforts by our Athornaans to spread our religion in olden times!

An oblique reference for the propagation is in Yasna 9.24 as regards Hom Yazata (please see below).

# Hom Yasht Large – Yasna 9 – 10 and Yasna 11

In our last WZSE #302, we presented the meeting between Hom Yazata and Zarathushtra from Yasna 9.

This meeting is continued in Yasna 9, 10 and 11.

In this WZSE #302, we presented some background about Haoma plant, the Yasna ritual of creating Haoma juice and elevation of Haoma to a Yazata – Hom Yazata and Dasturji Dhalla's statement about Hom Yazata.

In the rest of Yasna 9 – 11, Hom Yazata talks about 4 people who praised him and in return got illustrious sons, Zarathushtra being one of them and various benefits accrued to people who worship Hom Yazata.

# Hom Yazata dethroned Keresaani bragging against Mobeds

In Yasna 9, Hom Yazata is said to dethrone a very proud King Keresaani, who bragged that no Mobeds will be allowed to propagate Zoroastrian Religion in his kingdom.

So here is this Verse 24 Yasna 9:

(24) Haomo temchit yim keresaanim apa-khshathrem nishaadhayat,

Yo raosta khshathro-kaamaya.

Yo davata noit meh apaam aathrava aiwishtish veredhyeh

Danghava charaat, ho vispeh varedhanaam vanaat,

ni vispeh varedhanaam janaat.

# Hom Yazata dethroned Keresaani bragging against Mobeds – Hom Yasht Large – Yasna 9 – Verse 24

(24) Hom dethroned him who was Keresaani by removing from sovereignty,

Who was swelled up in his ambition for sovereign power.

Keresaani during the period of his sovereignty bragged with pride:

Never henceforth in my land shall any Aathravan, teacher move about for propagating

#### Zoroastrian Religion, because he will destroy the whole of my increase,

#### And he will ruin the whole of my prosperity.

(Translation from Kangaji – English Khordeh Avesta – Hom Yasht Large – Pages 343 - 344)

## **SPD** Comments

- 1. This is another reference from olden Avesta about the propagation of the Holy Zoroastrian Religion.
- 2. In the above verse, it is noted that Aathravans (Mobeds) were going to various countries in olden times, teaching and propagating the Zoroastrian Religion.
- 3. In Ferdowsi's Shahnameh, Hom Yazata appears as a hermit, dweller of the mountains, incredibly strong. He binds evil Afraasiaab (Avestan: "the fell Turaanian Frangrasyaan", Yasna11.7) with the sacred girdle, and drags him from deep within the earth (named the hankana in Avestan, hang-e-Afraasiaab in middle Persian) where Afraasiaab has his "metal-encircled" kingdom that is immune to mortal attack. King Kai Khushroo then killed Afraasiaab who murdered his father Kai Siaavux. (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Haoma)
